

Ten Little Chicks

Nursery rhymes are full of rhyme, rhythm and repetition.

Singing and reciting nursery rhymes boosts children's language and literacy skills.

Demonstrate the finger actions and then practise these with the children. Younger children may find it difficult to focus on more than a couple of actions.

Five and five eggs

(Hold up one hand and then both)

makes ten.

Sitting on top is the mother hen.

(Fold one hand over the other)

Crack crack crack!

(Clap hands three times)

What do I see?

(Fingers around eyes)

Ten fluffy chicks

As yellow as can be

(Hold up ten fingers)
